



Dearest Reader,

For so many, it was a year of hardship. And, you saw it . . . felt it, too.

Excellence. Accountability. Impact.™

If you could—you **dug deep when it came to your charitable giving**. Volunteers made thousands of cloth masks given freely to any and all, checked on neighbors, lauded and fed our community's healthcare workers. Together, we developed heightened awareness of those who lost jobs, families that couldn't pay rents or mortgages, neighbors who needed help with food, the struggles of distance learning, those who needed safe haven from escalating domestic and child abuse, and those among us who lost their lives or loved ones. The disparities in our community, so rich in diversity in race and ethnicity, came into sharp relief.

Because of all of this—because of you—2020 became *the year of community*.

In *the year of community*, **nonprofits stepped up as never before**—some serving more than triple clientele. Fundraising events were canceled. Staff got laid off. Volunteers numbering in the tens of thousands had to stay home. New staff were hired and had to be trained. Stress and triage comingled with care and commitment.

Through it all, safety-net services stepped up to the plate.

Partnerships and collaborations kept our community fueled. The value of public and private partnerships became undeniable and personal. Nonprofits and local governments, along with local funding institutions, developed a collaborative rhythm. In *the year of community*, organizations and the people who led them did everything within their personal power to step into voids the other could not fill—to help animals, to help businesses, to help people.

To help community.

For our part in *the year of community*, our grantmaking doubled, year over year, from \$1.2 million to \$2.2 million. Our Board and Committee meetings, along with our nonprofit training workshops and capacity building efforts, retained educational value and interactive qualities—including the ever-present reminder, "you're on mute." We launched our *Racial Equity Framework* amid our nation's unspeakable tragedies, civic outcry, and racial reckoning. We stepped into a unique niche, granting to Black and Brown business owners. Working with our nonprofit community, we came alongside government messaging and the Medical Reserve Corp to help get neighbors tested for COVID-19. In short, your Community Foundation staff and Board of Directors dedicated its resources to stay in lock step with community needs and to find solutions.

You are our solution, our resource, our fuel. You move us forward toward healing, safety, and rebuilding. You may have heard us say it before. It is worth repeating as we reflect on *the year of community* . . . because of you . . . community wasn't the beneficiary . . . community was the solution. *Thank you.*

The Work We Do

Despite the challenges of 2020, our work and programs continued, pivoting to online classrooms and virtual meetings. During the year, 305 unduplicated community leaders join in our programs to build on our collective strengths and meet our respective missions.



Since its debut in 2014, Give Choose has generated \$2.6 million benefitting local charities in this community-wide “crowd funding” online event. For 24 hours each spring, gifts of \$10 or more benefit a charity of donor choice. Many participating charities have challenge funds, doubling each gift a donor makes. Generous corporate sponsors create a “prize pool” building excitement and incentivizing giving from thousands of generous donors. More than 90 charities from all categories complete a local catalog of our community’s most active social service sector at GiveChoose.org. **Watch for it on March 29, 2022.**



Getting personalized support and specialized training are rare opportunities for nonprofit executives and professionals. The Social Impact Institute offers that kind of support. In 2020, we launched **the Leadership Institute**, a leadership development program for nonprofit executive leaders and managers, all of whom face the challenges of care and feeding of their board of directors, fundraising pressures, supervision and management, and ensuring their organization’s mission and strategic goals are on track. In addition, we renewed our **Board Chair Roundtable**, offering nonprofit board chairs shared learning and peer support, and hosted an annual **Learning Lab** workshop series on grant-writing and grant or research for nonprofit grant seekers.



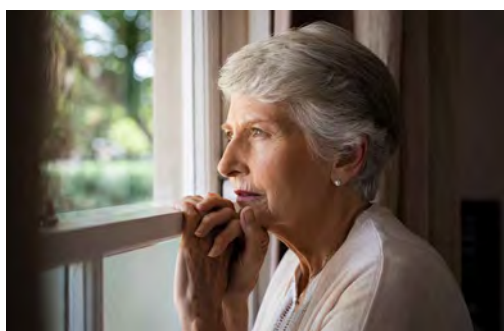
Funded by our endowment fund named the S. Murray Rust and Mary H.C. Rust Student Philanthropy Project, Forward Turn partners with the Loudoun Parks and Recreation’s Youth Advisory Council for this annual program empowering youth to become community grantmakers. Students learn to review proposals, interview grantee applicants, and make tough grants decisions.



In partnership with the Loudoun Chamber of Commerce and its Nonprofit Initiative, the Community Foundation renewed the Nonprofit Academy workshop series to build the capacity and knowledge of local leaders in fundraising, public relations and outreach, and finance and administration.



Launched in April 2020, the Racial Equity Framework provides a series of programs for nonprofit leaders, government service providers, and community stakeholders to address racial equity and justice in our community. Participants joined The Onion Dialogues, an interactive workshop presented by Amy Owen and Tamara Copeland, designed to help participants learn to talk candidly about race and racism. Allyship, presented by Whitney Parnell of Service Never Sleeps, took participants further on the learning journey, offering tools to become allies for racial justice. The Community Foundation capped the year by offering capacity-building Racial Equity Audits for three nonprofit organizations to aid in identifying and refining policies and practices aligned with equity, diversity, and inclusion.



COVID-19

Through our Community Emergency Relief Fund and in partnership with our fund holders including 100WomenStrong, Loudoun Community Cabinet, and Tourism & Hospitality Fund, we granted more than \$1.2 million in direct COVID-19 relief funding to support nonprofits and charities providing direct services to those in need. Aided by additional and generous contributions of individuals and corporations across the community, we helped lead response and recovery efforts through a number of initiatives, including the creation of the Loudoun COVID-19 Emergency Fund and Helpline providing rental assistance to our neighbors in need; a COVID-19 testing outreach campaign reaching Latinx and vulnerable communities; and a Minority-Owned Small Business Grants Program.



Opened in 2019, the Claude Moore Nonprofit Training Center was utilized in the first quarter of 2020. We successfully switched to virtual programs and look forward to its future use.

Creating a Personal Legacy

This is About You

Your fund is a reflection of your values and philanthropy. From animal welfare, to human services and health, to youth and elderly, to specific charities you support, we can make it easy and rewarding. **Are you thinking about setting up a charity or foundation? Talk to us first.** We can help you understand the current nonprofit sector. And, we may serve as an excellent vehicle for your vision. We will work with you to answer the following questions to help determine when starting a fund or foundation with us is the right path.

Define Your Charitable and Financial Objectives

Consider how you want your gift to be used, whether you want future family members involved, and how much involvement you personally want in making grant recommendations.

Choose a Name For Your Fund

Many donors choose a family name, but you can use any name that is meaningful to you.

Determine Which Assets You Will Use to Create Your Fund

Gifts of cash, securities (publicly traded or closely held), or real estate can be accepted by the Community Foundation to set up a fund. Assets with a low-cost basis are often wise choices, since they offer maximum tax advantages: You pay no capital gains tax and receive a favorable income-tax deduction. You may also wish to review assets inside your retirement plan for possible charitable use. If you wish, we will work closely with your accountant and attorney to ensure your charitable wishes are clearly understood and applied.

Consider the Type of Fund that Matches Your Interests

Our staff will help you identify what type of fund fits your vision! It may help, though, to understand how broad and flexible we can be as a giving vehicle with our array of donor crafted funds.

Make Your Gift to the Community Foundation

While your gifts to establish a fund will be commingled with other Community Foundation assets for maximum investment benefits, income and appreciation are specifically tracked and tied to your fund, benefiting your fund for its growth and charitable grantmaking.

Make a Gift Through Your Will

Appropriate language to make sure your will meets legal and tax criteria is available. Just ask!

Acorn Fund

Many of our philanthropists start a new fund by creating an acorn fund, building to the endowed level of \$10,000 over a 5-year period (\$25,000 for scholarship funds). An initial gift of \$2,000 (\$5,000 for scholarship funds) or more is necessary to “seed” any of the funds below. And, many of our acorn funds build endowment while also granting funds immediately.

Field of Interest Fund

This type of fund allows you to target an issue of need rather than a specific charity. Grants are made to organizations that meet a cause or specific need. You define the “area of interest,” and grantmaking follows.

Donor Advised Fund

Donor advised funds closely mirror private family foundations, but they offer significant advantages. A donor advised fund allows you to enjoy ongoing, even day-to-day, involvement in the distribution of your gifts from your fund. You bring specific grant recommendations to the Community Foundation for consideration. Learn more on page 12.

Designated Fund

You may name a specific charity to benefit from your gift or numerous specific charities to receive annual grants. Should a designated organization cease to exist, the Community Foundation has the responsibility and authority to reallocate grants to another agency that most closely reflects your original vision.

Agency Fund

Charities often wish to create long-term endowments to benefit their mission and purpose. The Community Foundation provides an excellent vehicle to ensure endowment gifts are carefully and diversely invested and managed.

Scholarship Fund

You may choose to dedicate a fund's purpose entirely to helping students study and advance their education. The Community Foundation works with community volunteers to interview students and make award recommendations, or we can work with you to form your own Board-approved selection committee.

Giving Circle Fund

Many of our funds are created by a collective vision of multiple donors, who each tithe into a "giving circle," and then, together, make grant recommendations. Giving circles are a fantastic way to learn more about your local community and its charities and increase impact as each grant is amplified in size.

General Fund

A gift to establish a general or unrestricted fund helps meet the changing needs of your community, now and in the future. General funds broadly support the wellbeing and vitality of our community.

When you establish a general fund, you leave decisions about the use of your gift to the Community Foundation, trusting the Community Foundation's knowledge and reach to determine what needs are most pressing.

Corporate Advised Funds

Corporations often are overwhelmed with requests for charitable gifts. Many corporations across America look to their local Community Foundation for a simplified, focused giving program, administered by Community Foundation staff. A corporation can establish a corporate advised fund applying personalized guidelines for grantmaking. Or, it may elect to give the Community Foundation full discretion over disbursements.

Shell Fund—Planned Giving

The Community Foundation is available to work with you and your financial advisors to set up what we call a "shell agreement." A shell agreement is a nonbinding agreement that specifies how your planned gift shall be used once it is irrevocably received through your will or other planned-gift instrument.

In the shell agreement, you name your fund, outline your charitable vision, and decide whether donor advisors or the Community Foundation Board of Directors will recommend future grants. Gifts received from your planned gift will be placed into your fund exactly as you have named and designed it. We handle all future administrative details. When you create a planned gift using a shell agreement, revisions are easy, quick, and free. Just get in touch with us.

Transferring a Private Foundation or Trust Fund

A private foundation can be a great vehicle for charitable giving, but sometimes the process of managing the foundation's legal affairs can diminish the joy of giving or become a burden to maintain. Existing private foundations or charitable trust funds can be easily rolled over to a named endowment fund within the Community Foundation, greatly reducing administrative overhead, while maintaining key elements of donor involvement and long-term, legacy vision. The disadvantages of private foundations or trusts—excise fees, administrative fees, lesser tax benefits, and due diligence administration—cause many to seek a more flexible alternative through the Community Foundation.

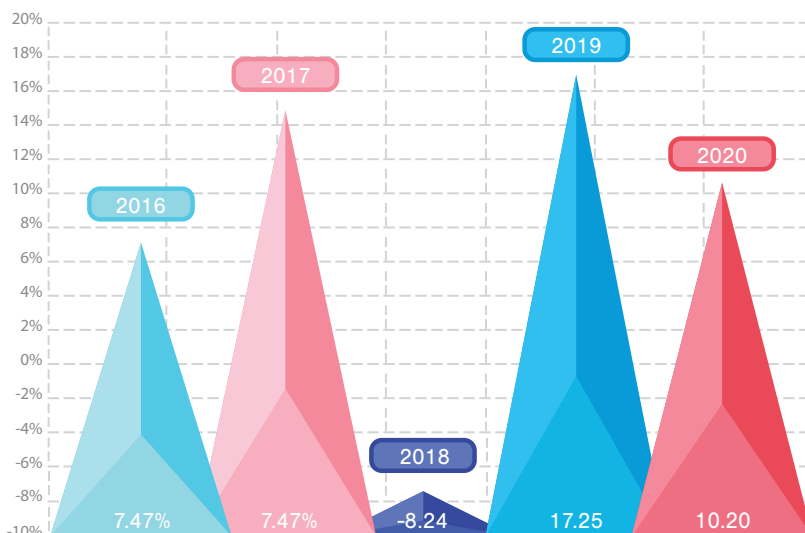

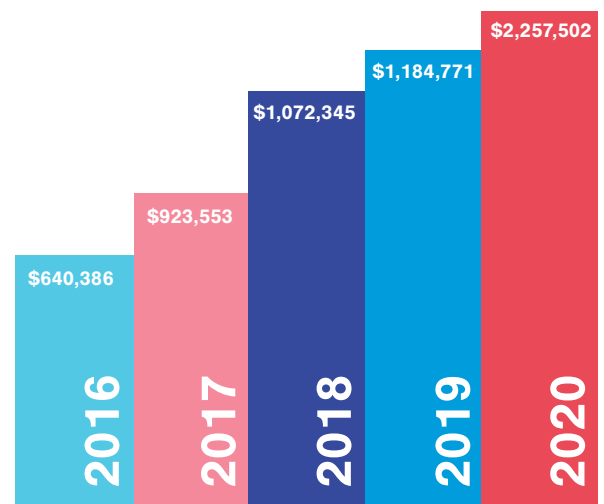

Community Emergency Relief Fund



The world pandemic had arrived at our front door. In response, on March 11, 2020, the Community Foundation launched a Community Emergency Relief Fund. With gifts from hundreds of fund holders, donors, businesses, and government programs, the Community Foundation granted more than \$1.2 million dollars in direct response to COVID-19.

Fund holders like 100WomenStrong, Loudoun Community Cabinet, Tourism & Hospitality Fund, along with such contributors as Google, Kaiser Permanente, MVB Bank, Visit Loudoun, Washington Gas, County of Loudoun, and hundreds of generous households and community businesses, all came together. Together, a collective focus was dedicated to meeting need through flexibility and impact.

The Community Foundation began by zeroing in on nonprofits that specialized in getting rent and utilities covered for newly unemployed and underemployed neighbors. We collaborated with partner nonprofits and the County of Loudoun to increase COVID-19 testing among our most disproportionately impacted neighbors. We offered a unique grants program supporting minority-owned small businesses on the edge of financial loss. Funding provided to nonprofits offered “general support” with no programmatic strings attached to enable continuity in service provision for food, learning, health, aid, and care in our community for thousands of those in need. Donors and funders continue to support the Fund recognizing that, for many of our neighbors, it may take years to recover the lost savings and quality of life achieved before March 11th.

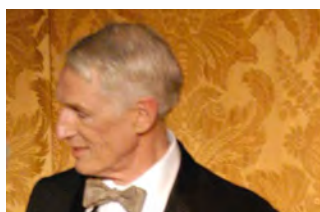

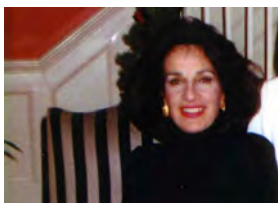
